Wildlife Retreat at Taronga, NSW

Utilising solar power, recycled water systems and timber structures designed to minimise environmental impact, the retreat also helps to fund the Taronga Conservation Society Australia, which supports conservation and educational programs around the world.

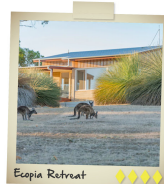
Ecopia Retreat, SA
